This report contains what I currently know (as of August 2012) about the descendants of Peter & Susan (Stoner) Leslie. Limited information is shown for anyone not known by me to have died and nothing is shown for generations beyond their great-great-greatgrandchildren. If you are also a descendant, please say hello, or if you think you might be a descendant, ask me for help to determine if that is true - my e-mail address is still

Please take a look at the 1923 Family Reunion newspaper article shown near the end of this report - there are a number of folks mentioned in this article that I don't recognize - perhaps you will.

Much of my research is based on census records. I try to find every person in every census after they left their parent's home. You can tell that I found a person in a particular census (1850, 1860, ..., 1930) if a place (city or township, county, and state) is mentioned for their residence in a census year. If I calculate year of birth based on the age given in a census, I simply subtract age from the census year and show it as "ca year", eg, for a person age 10 in 1880 I give $1880 - 10 = \text{ca } 1870$. Of course he could have been born in 1869. Exceptions include the 1900 census where the year of birth is given and the 1920 census where I use $1920 - \text{age} - 1$ and drop the "ca". None of my census findings are given a specific reference. Don't hesitate to contact me if you have a question.

ROBERT A. CONNELLY, Tippecanoe Township

Thomas Connelly, the father of this gentleman, was born in Charlottesville, Va., in the year 1787, and his mother, Elizabeth H. Connelly, was born near the same place, in 1791. In 1805, they moved from Virginia to Kentucky, remaining citizens of that State for a period of thirty years. In 1835, they came to Indiana, and located in Tippecanoe County. They were energetic farmers, and were among the earliest settlers of the township in which they resided. Both were exemplary members of the Christian Church, and were highly esteemed by all their neighbors. Thomas Connelly died in the year 1859. His wife survived him fourteen years, when, in 1873, she, too, was called away by death.

Their son Robert was born in Montgomery County, Ky., September 29, 1819. During his boyhood he was deprived of educational privileges, and those enjoyed in later years were of a very limited nature. For his education he has been dependent, mainly, upon his studious disposition and his aptness in acquiring knowledge. He learned the trade of carpenter and joiner, and has followed that occupation successfully for thirty years.

On the 15th day of January, 1843, he married Miss Kate Leslie. The marriage ceremony was performed in the city of La Fayette, by Elder John O'Kane, of the Christian Church. The parents of this lady, Peter and Susan Leslie, were natives of Lehigh County, Penn. They subsequently removed from that county, locating in Eaton, Preble Co., Ohio, where their daughter Kate was born, July 18, 1825. Both parents are now deceased, the father having died in 1855, and the mother in 1869.

For many years, Robert Connelly and his wife have been active members of the Christian Church, and their Christian principles are shown forth in their daily life. Generous and charitable, they have not failed to secure the esteem and confidence of all by whom they are surrounded; and the many charitable acts of their lives will ever be held in grateful remembrance by needy recipients whose wants have been supplied by them.

(Note by Roger R. Connelly: I have been able to confirm all the names, dates, and places of events mentioned in this biography of my great-great-grandfather except for Charlottesville (in Albemarle County, VA) as the birth place of Thomas. All evidence points to Augusta County, not Albemarle County, as the residence of his parents in 1787.

The surname on the gravestones for both Thomas and his wife Elizabeth is spelled Conley and that is how I have spelled it in my history.)

ROBERT A. CONNELLY, one of the highly esteemed citizens of Tippecanoe Township, and a representative of one of the pioneer families of Tippecanoe County, was born in Montgomery County, Kentucky, September 29, 1819, a son of Thomas and Elizabeth H. Connelly, who immigrated to this county in the year 1835. During his boyhood our subject was deprived of educational privileges, and later in life they were of a very limited nature. Thus his education is due to his own studious disposition, and his aptness in acquiring knowledge. He learned the trade of carpenter and joiner, an occupation he followed successfully for many years. January 15, 1843, he was married in La Fayette, by Elder John O'Kane, of the Christian Church, to Miss Kate Leslie, a daughter of Peter and Susan Leslie, who were natives of Lehigh County, Pennsylvania. Her parents subsequently removed to Eaton, Preble County, Ohio, where Mrs. Connelly was born July 18, 1825. Her father died in the year 1855, her mother surviving the death of her husband until 1869. For many years Mr. and Mrs. Connelly have been active members of the Christian church, and their Christian principles are shown forth in their daily life. Generous and charitable they have not failed to secure the esteem and confidence of all by whom they are surrounded, and their many charitable acts will ever be held in grateful remembrance by all who have been benefitted (sic) by them. Nine children have been born to Mr. and Mrs. Connelly, three of whom are deceased - Susan E., Robert E. and Nancy M. Those living are named: Thomas W., Peter L., Frances Emily, Sally E., Kate E. and Joe Ella. Thomas W. married Miss Frank Cain, January 14, 1868; Peter L. was married to Linnie Dunlap, June 9, 1870, by Elder Graham; Amos Morehouse to Miss Sallie E. Connelly March 22, 1877, by Brother John Kolb; Clark Pearson to Kate E. Connelly, April 12, 1885, by Brother Aaron Walker, of Kokomo, and Miss Joe Ella to Hervey P. Rothrock, April 10, 1887, by Brother John Kolb. Besides their own children they have taken to their home and cared for as their own, a number of orphan and indigent children. Mrs. Connelly, or Aunt Kate as she is familiarly called, is well known for her motherly nature and kindness of heart, and her many acts of kindness will long be remembered. Mr. Connelly has disposed of considerable of his land, yet still owns his pleasant home farm where he has fifty acres of choice land. His father, Thomas Connelly, was born in Charlottesville, Virginia, in the year 1787, his mother being born near the same place in 1791. In 1805 they moved from Virginia to Kentucky, remaining citizens of that State a period of thirty years. In 1835 they came to Indiana, and located in Tippecanoe County. They were energetic farmers, and among the first settlers of the township in which they resided. Both were exemplary members of the Christian church, and were highly esteemed by all their neighbors. Thomas Connelly died in the year 1859. His widow survived him fourteen years, when, in 1873, she too was called away by death.

Biography of Robert D. Roberts

Robert D. Roberts, for many years prominent in the agricultural progress of Union Township and the industrial life of Monticello, died April 28, 1912, as the result of an injury received at his farm southwest of Monticello. He had been engaged in blasting rock on his land and had loaded it upon a boat for transportation, when a large stone fell upon him and injured him internally. The deceased was born in White County, January 21, 1837, being one of the eight children of John and Martha Roberts. His parents had located on a tract of 160 acres of Government land in 1831, occupying an Indian shack as their first

home. In that locality they lived until 1866, when they gave up farm life and moved to their new home on South Main Street, Monticello, where the father died in 1872. In 1861 Robert D. Roberts married Susan Scowden and for several years devoted himself to farming and stock raising; but in 1876, with William B. Keefer, under the firm name of Roberts and Keefer, he purchased the woolen factory which stood at the foot of the mill race on the east side of the river and converted it into a flour mill, giving it the name of the Crystal Mills. Some time later he purchased Mr. Keefer's interest and later took his nephew, Fred Roberts, as a partner; and they conducted the mill successfully until it was burned in 1889. Later he served a term as township trustee and as county commissioner. He continued to reside at his home on the hill east of the river dam, but devoted most of his time and attention to his large tract of land south of town. Mrs. Roberts died in December, 1910, the mother of five children. Though seventy-five years of age at the time of his death, Mr. Roberts was active physically and clear mentally, so that, despite his years, his death seemed premature.

(Note by RRC: His day of death is 27 on his gravestone; based on other sources, "five children" should be nine children.)

Biographical Sketch of Ralph Robert Connelly,
written by his son Barr Connelly

(Submitted by my brother, Barr, transcribed & edited by my wife, Shirley, December, 2005)

About Ralph: He was honest, trustworthy and loyal and a great DAD and husband. Dad's handshake was worth a signed contract today. He had a loyal following of 60-70 regular customers. He always said: I run the business - your mother runs the house. He gave Evelyn a \$50.00 allowance each month. He would always say "if only she could stay within that" - then he would laugh! He knew; antiquing, golfing, bowling, bridge club and the Methodist Church cost dearly. Ralph liked his athletics. He was a football, basketball, softball player while growing up. He played softball with the brickyard teams. He sponsored a men's bowling team for him and his buddies and a women's bowling team for Evelyn's friends. Connelly's Standard Service!

A fond memory I have is - Dad coming home from the station, eating and he and I walking over to Roosevelt Stadium to watch a semi-pro baseball game. We lived only 2 blocks from the diamond.

Generation 5 (con't)

My second fondest memory is - he and Mother never missed one of my football or basketball games during my entire high school career.

Ralph also enjoyed his monthly poker group, each month they would play at someone's home. When it was played at our house - they played in both the living room and dining room area and Mother was the hostess.

My father's best friend and great bowling buddy was Vern Herzog. Herzie was known to drive into Dad's station and the two of them would leave to practice bowling for 1 ½ to 2 hours at Dicks Lanes.

I remember too, Dick Hubbard, who not only played poker and bowled with Dad, but was a faithful employee of Father's for years. I worked along side of Dick from 1956 to 1972. He was Father's right hand man.

Dad enlisted in the Army in 1944 as a 38 yr. old guy. He and his business partner, Harry Arnold, had agreed to close up the station and join the service for WWII. Well, Dad passed his physical and went to basic training and on into Italy, north of Rome was where he was when the war ended. Harry went down to enlist after Father; he did not pass his physical exam and so he stayed home and kept the gas station running.

My father, I know would not have retired from the station at age 65 as he did. He retired only because of an onset of diabetes. He loved his work, his customers and got so much joy and satisfaction from helping his regular customers.

His regular customers would charge all their expenses on a credit slip and settle up with father every month or whatever was best for them.

I love to tell the story of - how Dad and Johnny Neibergal, a grocer, did their business together. Mother would call on the phone and put in her grocery order which Johnny would fill and then deliver the groceries to our house. Johnny then drove to the station, filled up his delivery truck and settled the bill with Dad. There was never an exchange of money, just acknowledgment of there was a "credit" or "debit"! At some time they would settle up, I'm sure, but otherwise their records just continued on as a + or -.

Another of Dad's regular customers who charged every item was a Milwaukee Railroad man who did not own a car or even have a driver's license. Whenever he was out with his lady friends, he would have them come into the station for gas, oil, grease, tires, etc. He put all the charges on his account with Dad. He always paid his account as Dad would cash his Milwaukee Railroad check each month.

Dad paid Roger .75 an hour when Roger worked for him. When I began working for him in 1956, he paid me \$1.25/hour.

He loved his favorite car - a 1952 Packard. He did buy a new car in 1962 - a Chevy Biscayne. He always had a "junker" car for his use at the station.

I recall using used drain oil to burn out 2 tree stumps in our yard on 15th Street.

Dad also used drain oil to oil down a dusty South Carolina road near our house on 15th Street.

Their monthly house payment on 15th Street was \$25.00. They bought the home on Clover Lane for cash (used his Government E-Bonds).

My high school basketball team pushed Mom and Dad's car free from being buried in a snowdrift at Highway 18 and Highway 69 - we were all coming home in a terrible snowstorm from Webster City.

Solomon Leslie date of death unknown.

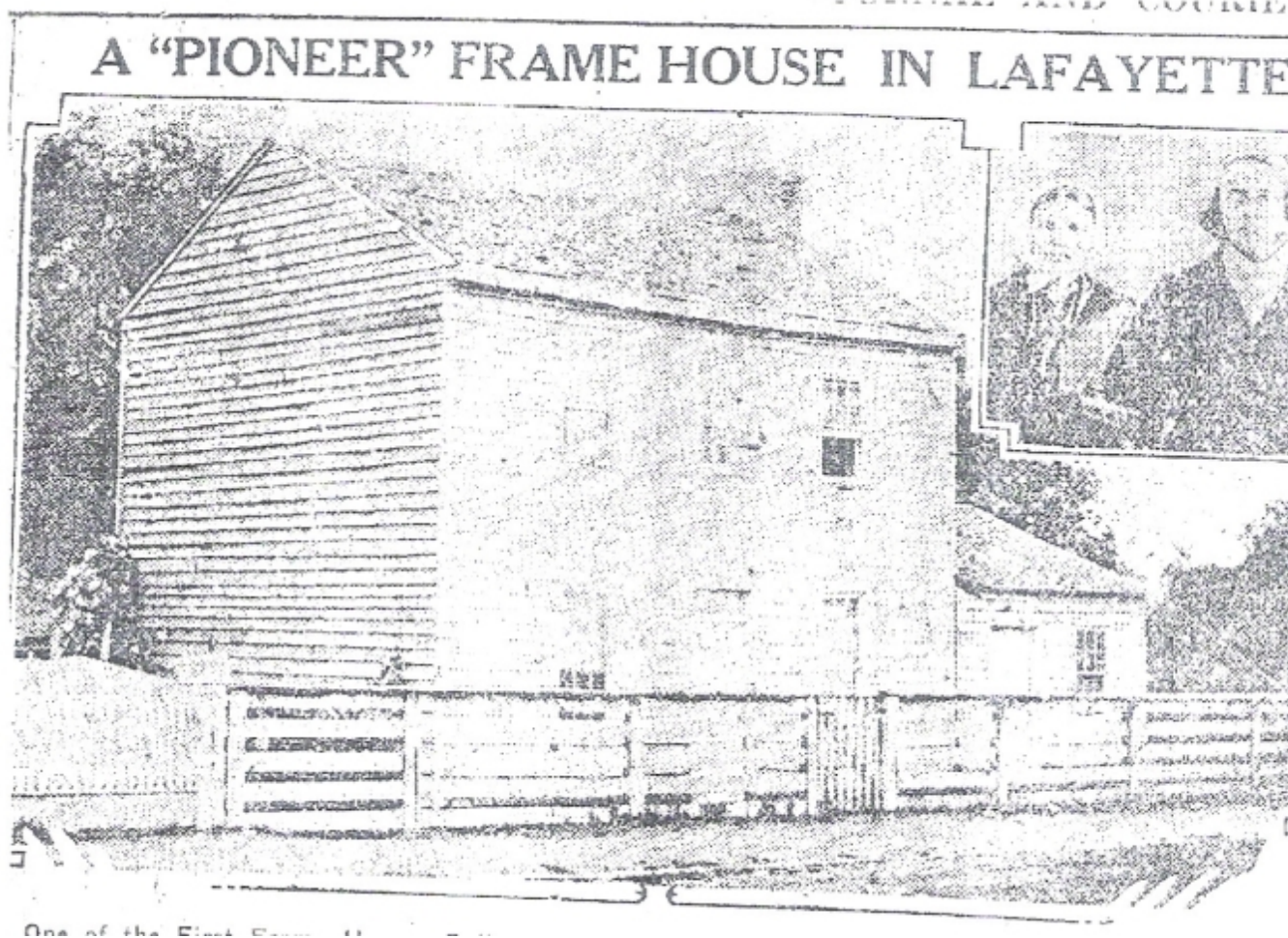
~~They were a family and all did their share helping~~

Leslie frame house in Lafayette, IN, 1830; built by Peter Leslie

(Transcribed by RRC from a photocopy of the original article in the Lafayette Journal and Courier, Lafayette, IN, 1925.)



One of the First Frame Houses Built in Lafayette, and the Man Who Built It, With His Wife, Mr. and Mrs. Peter Leslie.

In the first days of the city frame houses were a rarity. Then all houses were built of logs. In 1828, Peter Leslie and his wife came to Lafayette from Preble county, Ohio, and two years later, in 1830, they built the frame house here shown for their home. Descendants are not positive of its location, but are certain that it was situated somewhere near Tenth and Ferry streets. The photographs are

supplied by Mrs. Clark Pearson, of Muncie, a granddaughter of Peter and Susan Leslie. She recalls hearing her mother tell that she herded cows over most of what is now Lafayette. Some members of the Leslie family have resided in Lafayette since 1828.

Obituary.

ELIZABETH TEMPLETON.

Elizabeth Leslie was born in Eaton, Preble county, Ohio, September 9th, 1820, and when eight years of age removed with her parents to this State, locating in LaFayette, in the year 1828. Her father was one of the number who organized the first Christian church in this State. The deceased, Elizabeth Leslie, united with the Christian church while attending yearly meeting at Crawfordsville, Ind., sometime during the year 1837. She was married to Joshua Scowden when 19 years of age. To this union was born eight children, six of whom survive her. Joshua Scowden departed this life in the year 1863.

After a widowhood of four years she was united in marriage in 1867 to J. Templeton, who departed this life some years since, the exact date not being known to the writer. Once more the deceased was left a widow, and remained so until her death, which occurred October 5, 1892, aged 72 years, and 26 days. She was a loving wife, a devoted mother, and faithful to her God, having lived a true Christian life for fifty-five years. She leaves a large circle of relatives and friends to mourn her departure, but what is their loss is her gain.

Funeral services were held at the home of deceased on Friday, October 7th, 1892, at 11 o'clock a. m., conducted by Mac Myers. After the funeral services the body was conveyed to the cemetery, 2 1/2 miles south-east of Reynolds, Ind., where the body was laid away to moulder back to mother earth from whence it came, and the spirit returns to God who gave it.

I recognize most of the attendees of this LESLIE family reunion but not all of them. The following are those I really need help with as I can't link them to Peter & Susan (Stoner) Leslie:

Isaac Pearson. I'm fairly sure that he was a brother of Clarkson Pearson, both being children of Hiram & Charity (Hollingsworth) Pearson. I'm not aware of any connection of Hiram or Charity to Peter or Susan (Stoner) Leslie, so I think Isaac was an invited guest to the reunion; Mrs. Clarkson Pearson was Edith (Connelly) Pearson (1860 - 1943), a known descendant of Peter & Susan (Stoner) Leslie.

Harold Chilcott. I suspect this is Harold E. Chilcott, b 1902, s/o Garfield P. & Dora (Wagoner) Chilcott.

Miss Pearl Hinshaw

Miss Zenoba Sparks. I suspect this is Zenobia Sparks, born 15 April 1911, d/o Lewis & Pearl (Gordon) Sparks. Zenobia married Ancil E. Ayres in 1930; Ancil died in 1975; Zenobia died in 2004. Zenobia's mother, Pearl (Gordon) Sparks, was born 22 June 1892, d/o Everett & Sarah (Grantham) Gordon.)

Speculating on the parents of Peter Leslie (1792 - 1855)

Peter is often said to be a son of the Peter Leslie who married Susannah Walther on 18 January 1749, but I (RRC) doubt it. Carol Jones of Rushville, Indiana, has made an interesting observation which was published in Blaine F. Winslow's newsletter "Leslie Leaves and Twigs & Branches", Vol. 5, No. 4, November 2005:

Blaine,

I was just going over some of the information we've exchanged on the Peter Lesley who married Susan Stoner. The discussion was whether this Peter was actually the son of Peter and Susannah.

To refresh your memory, I questioned whether he was their son because Susannah would have been 62 years old when he was born. You responded by saying he could have been the son of one of their daughters and claimed as their own. I just came up with something very interesting that might support your theory.

Margaret, who married Adam Swinehart, was 31 years old when she married (spinster age in those days) and Adam was appointed one of Peter's guardians. She would have been 28 when Peter was born, and she is the only daughter that was not married when Peter was born. Interesting coincidence, especially when you note that a Peter Lesley was living near the Adam Swinehart's in Miami County, Ohio on the 1820 census who is married and with one daughter.
Carol.

I (RRC) like this hypothesis. There is a slight error in Carol's observation; the folks she mentions in the 1820 census were enumerated in Jackson Twp., Montgomery County, OH, not Miami County. I'm sure this error was made because Ancestry.com incorrectly indexes the entire Montgomery County, OH, census in 1820 as Miami County. Also of interest to me are the many other Lesleys enumerated on pages 120-122, especially the Hester Lesley enumerated on the same page, 120, as Peter. Hester is probably the widow of Jacob Leslie & the daughter of Gabriel & Barbara (Ripling) Swinehart.
